

# ART HOME LEARNING POLICY

## *WHY IS ART HOME LEARNING IMPORTANT FOR MY CHILD?*

### ART HOME LEARNING IS IMPORTANT BECAUSE IT:

- Increases the student's practice of art skills, techniques, and thinking strategies,
- Reinforces what the student has learned in class,
- Prepares students for future lessons,
- Develops student responsibility and,
- Develops student organizational and planning skills.

## ART HOME LEARNING IS A REQUIRED WEEKLY ASSIGNMENT FOR GRADES 2 THROUGH 5.

- THE STUDENT WILL HAVE AN ART HOME LEARNING SKETCHBOOK WHICH INCLUDES A FOLDER, AN ASSIGNMENT RECORD SHEET, AND PAPER
- ASSIGNMENTS INVOLVE ARTMAKING AND RESEARCH WHERE THE STUDENT WILL USE ART MATERIALS AT HOME
- STUDENTS WILL SPEND AT LEAST ONE HOUR ON THE ASSIGNMENT. . HOME LEARNING IS DUE IN THE SKETCHBOOK FOLDER PROTECTED BY A PLASTIC BAG
- HOME LEARNING IS DUE ON TIME. . STUDENT ABSENCE FROM ART CLASS IS NOT AN ACCEPTABLE EXCUSE FOR NOT DOING AN ASSIGNMENT. STUDENTS HAVE ONE WEEK TO MAKE UP WORK.
- STUDENTS LEARN TO ASSESS THEIR OWN LEVEL OF ACHIEVEMENT IN THE HOME LEARNING THROUGH SELF-EVALUATION. A= COMPLETE/ON TIME, C= INCOMPLETE, F= MINIMAL EFFORT/NO WORK
- HOME LEARNING IS 30 PERCENT OF THE ACADEMIC GRADE

- 2<sup>ND</sup> TIME: TIME OUT, LOWER CONDUCT GRADES
- 3<sup>RD</sup> TIME: PARENT CONTACT BY LETTER/PHONE
- 4<sup>TH</sup> TIME: TEACHER/PARENT/STUDENT CONFERENCE
- 5<sup>TH</sup> TIME: ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION

### IF A STUDENT DOES THE RIGHT THING:

1. VERBAL PRAISE
2. POSITIVE NOTES HOME
3. INCENTIVES: SPECIAL ACTIVITIES, AWARDS, TEACHER HELPER
4. GOOD CONDUCT GRADES
